Covid information for Match Days - please read and share

ARRIVING AT KING HENRY SCHOOL

Please be aware that King Henry School will have a QR barcode to support the NHS track and trace system. This means that anyone entering the facilities will need to Download the NHS Covid 19 app. This will allow you to scan the QR barcodes at the main entrance to the sports centre.

All players, coaches & umpires must have completed the England Hockey Participation agreement before arrival

BEFORE THE GAME

Please arrive no more than 30 minutes before your scheduled push back time and depart promptly after your match has finished. Time at the ground must be limited.

Please come changed and ready to play as there are no changing facilities. Toilets will be open.

Playing teams are to use far side of the pitch for bags and substitutions. The next arriving teams are to wait outside of the pitch on the left until pitch area is cleared, this will minimise over-crowding on team changeover.

Please do not enter the playing cage until all participants from the preceding game have left.

DURING THE GAME

Sorry, spectators must be kept to an absolute minimum. Any spectators who need to be there (e.g. parents of under 18s) must remain by yellow storage boxes on the left hand side of the pitch, or outside of the cages and observe normal social distancing rules in groups of no more than 6.

Only players, umpires, managers and coaches for the game time are allowed pitch side. Coaches and subs on the side-line must observe normal social distancing rules.

Please vacate the playing cage as soon as your match has finished so that the next game can get onto the pitch and warm up.

PARTICIPATION LISTS / TRACK & TRACE

Each team is responsible for recording all their own participants visiting the site and sending this information to England Hockey within 24 hours in line with published guidance (i.e. away teams must submit their own attendance record, BBHC is not responsible for taking a register of away teams).
